Pastor Jonathan's Sabbatical Plans

- 5/25 – 6/10 SABBATICAL BEGINS MAY 25. Jonathan will work on his family tree. Jonathan and his mother will visit the first churches his grandfather served in Rantoul and Gifford IL, and then see his Great Aunt in St. Clairsville, OH.
- 6/11 – 6/27 The Warren family will fly to London where they will tour London and Paris for several days each. Then they'll rent a car to tour Oxford, Bath, Warwick, York. Along with historical sites, they will balance family fun stops including Disneyland Paris, Harry Potter Leavesden Studios, and a Medieval Festival.
- 6/28 – 7/22 SCOTLAND FAMILY EXCHANGE: The Warren family will stay in the Noonan home in Houston, Scotland. Pastor Jonathan will preach the first three Sundays in July (7/2, 7/9, 7/16) at the Houston Killellan Kirk. In Scotland, they will connect with the community and explore church heritage sites.
- 7/23 – 7/28 The Warren family will rent a car and travel to scenic place in Ireland, including Giant's Causeway, Cliffs of Moher, and the Dingle Peninsula, and Dublin. Jonathan's grandfather had a pastoral exchange in Dublin in 1963.
- 7/29 – 8/7 While the rest of the family travels home, Jonathan will attend a weeklong retreat on the Isle of Iona, a 6th century monastery and retreat center. After the retreat, Jonathan will meet the Noonan family, then travel home.
- 8/11 – 8/17 Jonathan will travel to Lancaster, PA with his father to see many important places to his great-grandparents, including First Presbyterian Church of Lancaster. They will enjoy sites, share stories, and eat great food together.
- 8/18 – 8/25 Jonathan and Siobhan will take this last week to work on a family scrapbook. Jonathan will schedule appointments with a counselor and coach to reflect. SABBATICAL ENDS AUG 25.
